**The meeting will be at the Raytown Parks and Recreation Department Office, 5912 Lane Ave, Raytown, MO.** We will discuss the rules for the 2022 season. As Managers, you are members of the Rules Committee - if you want your opinion heard, you need to be there. Team league fees, rosters, and registration must be received by **April 4th**. If team fees are not paid by April 4th, then your team will not be on the league schedule.

The fees include 44 core 375 compression rating optic yellow balls (furnished by Raytown Parks & Recreation). League members are required to complete and sign a **2022 League Membership Form** and pay the **\$20 annual membership fee** before playing their first game. New players must also provide **age verification**. It is the responsibility of the team manager as well as the team member to make sure that each team member is properly enrolled. All league forms and schedules may be found on the HASSKC website.

Any manager allowing a player to participate without paying the membership fee will result in an automatic game forfeit. The said player's membership fee would then be \$25 and the manager would be subject to a \$50 fine per player and/or a league suspension. **No exceptions to this rule!**

A \$50 fee will also be charged when a team requires a schedule change after the schedules are printed. For example, pay your league fees by the deadline. Inform the league of tournament games to be played during that session when your team players will be out of town for a league game night.
